SUSTAINABLE ECONOMIC DIVERSIFICATION

Boost Angola's non-oil exports, global market integration, and decent job creation, with focus on value chains, trade integration, environment, renewable energy and economy formalisation.

GOVERNANCE

Support Angola's governance reform and sustainable economic diversification agenda.

- Rule of Law and economic governance: strengthen the justice system, fight organised crime and support public finance management reforms
- Civil society: enhance civil society's role in policy dialogues and foster citizens' participation in governance to promote transparency and accountability

HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

Technical and Vocational Education and Training: equip Angolan workers, including women and youth, with the relevant skills to contribute to the country's economic diversification.
